Forty Hours' Time Slots 'Could you not watch one hour with me?': Spend time with Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament over this period. It is a great blessing for our parish and families. Kindly add your name to a specific time so that there is always someone present with Our Lord.

40 Hours' Votive Candles there will be the opportunity to have a candle lit on the sanctuary for your own intentions. For example, a sick relative, a deceased family member or a special intention. Every candle will be labeled and burn for the 40 Hours. If you would like a candle, please complete the sheet at the back of the church and place £3.00 per candle in the piety stall.

The Forty Hours' Adoration the custom of having the Blessed Sacrament exposed for forty hours is to commemorate the forty hours that we lost His presence when He died and was placed for forty hours in the tomb. Millions have found that spending time in silence before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament becomes a life-changing experience. Consider giving some time to come and pray before Jesus exposed on the altar during the 40 Hours' Exposition in our parish.
