





Fr John Gordon

Fr John Gordon was born in Port Glasgow in 1936. He received his seminary education at Drygrange. He was ordained in St Patrick's Kilsyth by His Grace Archbishop Gordon Joseph Gray subsequently His Eminence Cardinal Gray on 18th March 1965 (not as is written on his ordination card 4th April 1965.) He was ordained in the new St Patrick's church as part of a double ordination to the Priesthood together with Fr Patrick Brady also from Kilsyth, on the day after the new Church had been opened. His first appointment was as assistant Priest at St Cuthbert's in Edinburgh where he was stationed from 1965 – 1972. He then became a military chaplain for 2 years until 1976. There are no further entries in the diocesan records regarding Fr Gordon thereafter.
